Hellé Synopsis

Set in the 1900's a French model and cabaret dancer takes on the man's world of motor sport after a skiing accident ended her career as a dancer. She becomes the female goddess of racing, admired by both men and women. After a major crash at the hands of the wheel in 1939 Hellé finds herself in a coma and hospitalized for two months eventually recovering to enter another race. Accused of collaborating with the Gestapo this iconic female died destitute, alone and unable to clear her name. A powerful captivating story of a provocative female racing driver who raced the French Yacco endurance trials. Hellé drove for ten days and ten nights and broke ten records that still stand today. Yet this incredible woman who died nameless eventually in 2008 was gifted a memorial plaque on her previously unmarked grave by a foundation established in her name.
